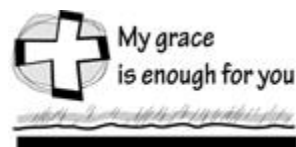

We seek out the poorest of the poor in 16 different countries, aiding some of the most destitute. In each face we see the living Christ, who is hungry, thirsty, a stranger and naked. Our ministry focuses on the greatest needs of the destitute. Just as our Lord served those society ignored, we are there; feeding the hungry, building water wells for thirsty villages, building houses for the homeless, aiding the impoverished elderly, raising orphans in a loving atmosphere of Christian Discipline, healing the sick or overcoming illiteracy by supporting schools. 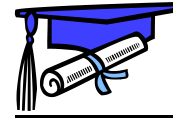

Each year on the 20<sup>th</sup> of July, we celebrate the Feast of St. Elias (prophet Elijah) who lived in Palestine in the 9<sup>th</sup> century before Christ. We read about his life and miracles in the Scriptures in 1 Kings 17 to 2 Kings 2. There the story is told that he was carried up to heaven in a fiery chariot. For this reason, he has become the Patron of drivers and the Protector of various means of transportation.

On St. Elias's feast or on the weekend nearest his feast, it is the practice in some parishes to bless cars with Holy Water after Mass.
