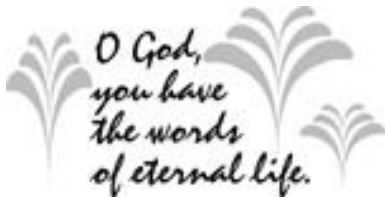
**A CALL TO SERVE**
