**FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY**

Once again, our St. Bonaventure's community generously supported the Father English Center food collection on Saturday, September 26th by contributing:

- 34 frozen dinners
- 54 bags of groceries
- 15 cartons of canned goods
- 50 lbs. of sugar
- 12 bags of used clothing
- 2 pkgs. of frozen vegetables
- 1 frozen turkey
- 4 frozen chickens
- 270 lbs. of rice
- 2 cartons of fresh vegetables

These totals include 18 bags of groceries and 50 pounds of rice contributed by our Knights of Columbus Council #240. As well as 7 bags of groceries and 2 frozen dinners donated by residents of Mountain Ridge Towers in West Paterson.

Thanks to all who made this food donation possible and particularly to that parishioner who provided 9 frozen dinners with the help of neighbors and friends. We are also most grateful to the Passaic County Police Academy's Class 15-45 who contributed 15 bags of groceries and 5 cartons of canned goods. The fresh vegetables were provided by our parish's Community Garden.

Please realize that many men and women who desperately want to work cannot find full-time jobs. So to keep body and soul together, they are taking part-time or temporary work that too often pays far less than they need to feed their families. With your continued support, the Father English Food Pantry helps feed them. You are literally saving these people from hunger!

Please, as we go about our lives this month, continue to remember the poor and hungry in our midst and prepare for our next collection of groceries and frozen dinners on **Saturday, October 24th**.
