FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY

Once again, our St. Bonaventure's community generously supported the Father English Center food collection on Saturday, November 21st by contributing:

48 frozen dinners	11 frozen turkeys
64 bags of groceries	1 frozen chicken
3 cartons of canned goods	20 bags of used clothing
90 lbs. of rice
