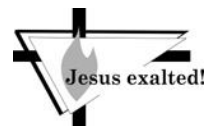

**FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY**

Our St. Bonaventure community generously supported the food collection for the Father English Center, on Saturday, March 19<sup>th</sup>. Contributions included:

These totals include 20 bags of groceries, 6 dozen eggs and 2 hams contributed by our Knights of Columbus Council #240. As well as 5 bags of groceries, 3 frozen dinners, 1 ham and 1 bag of used clothing donated by residents of Mountain Ridge Towers in West Paterson. Thanks to all who made this donation possible and particularly to that parishioner who provided 8 frozen dinners with the help of neighbors and friends.

These days we hear far too many stories of people who have been laid off or had their hours cut. It's especially hard for older, experienced workers, many of whom are overqualified for the jobs that are available. Those who are struggling to get by on a fraction of their former incomes face tough choices every day. Which to pay, the mortgage or utilities? What to do when the money and the food run out before the month is over? Thanks to your support, struggling moms and dads can at least put food on the table for their children.
