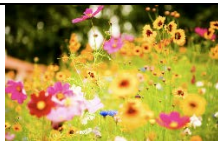

This month, parishes are asked to take up a combined collection for three worthy causes: the Catholic Communications Campaign, Catholic University and the Black and Indian Missions.


