FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY

Once again, our St. Bonaventure's community generously supported the Father English Center food collection on Saturday, December 16th by contributing:

30 frozen dinners 20 lbs frozen chicken breasts
27 bags of groceries 2 frozen turkeys
13 cartons of canned goods 14 bags of used clothing
\$250 in donations

These totals include a \$150 donation to the Community Food Bank of New Jersey for the account of the Fr. English Food Pantry made by our Knights of Columbus Council #240 as well as a \$100 donation to the same account made by a generous parishioner. Food totals also include 6 bags of groceries and 12 bags of used clothing donated by residents of Mountain Ridge Towers in West Paterson.

As we anticipate this month's collection, please reflect on the story of the ancient mystic who told of a man who, while walking one day past a beggar on the street asked, "Why, God do you not do something for these people?" God replied, "I did do something, I made you." There are still beggars among us! They make the line every morning in front of the Fr. English Food Pantry. God calls us to feed them!

Please, as we go about our lives this month, continue to remember the hungry in our midst and prepare for our next collection of groceries and frozen dinners on Saturday January 20th.
