FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY**

Once again, our St. Bonaventure's community generously supported the Father English Center food collection on Saturday, April 23rd by contributing:

- 22 frozen dinners
- 43 bags of groceries
- 6 cartons of canned goods
- 26 bags of used clothing
- 4 frozen turkeys
- 2 hams
- 200 lbs. of rice

These totals include 16 bags of groceries, 2 cartons of canned goods and 50 pounds of rice contributed by our Knights of Columbus Council #240. As well as 6 bags of groceries and 3 frozen dinners donated by residents of Mountain Ridge Towers in West Paterson.

There was an ancient mystic who told of a man who, while walking one day past a beggar on the street asked, "Why, God do you not do something for these people?" "God replied, "I did do something, I made you." There are still beggars among us! They make the line every morning in front of the Fr. English Food Pantry. It is God who calls us to feed them!

Please, as we go about our lives this month, continue to remember the hungry in our midst and prepare for our next collection of groceries and frozen dinners on Saturday, May 21<sup>st</sup>. As the diocese is seeking to replenish the food pantry shelves with specific food items, we have been asked to provide pancake mix, pancake syrup and toothpaste. We ask that you consider this need in your grocery donations.
