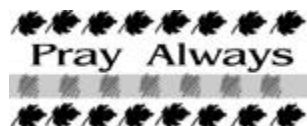

**Catholic Teaching & the Presidential Election**  
As we approach the next presidential election on **November 8<sup>th</sup>** many people are wondering what the role of our faith is in the election. While it is not the place of the Church to endorse candidates for political office, this does not mean our faith has nothing to say. On the contrary, our faith tells us that we should evaluate candidates for political office through the lens of Church teaching and vote for the candidate most likely to put these teachings into practice. To help with this task, St. Bon's will be presenting two resources between now and the election.

The first is a series of bulletin inserts that explain the Catholic understanding of certain issues relevant to this election. These articles are also available to download from our parish website.

The second is a presentation and discussion led by Fr. Stephen on the U.S. Bishops document, *Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship: A Call to Political Responsibility from the Catholic Bishops of the United States*.
