FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY

Our St. Bonaventure community generously supported the food collection for the Father English Center, on Saturday, April 15th. Contributions included:

- 32 frozen dinners
- 11 cartons of canned goods
- 38 bags of groceries
- 150 lbs. of rice
- 7 smoked hams
- 2 frozen chickens
- \$250 in donations
- 8 bags of used clothing

These totals include a \$150 donation to the NJ Food Bank for the account of the Fr. English Food Pantry made by our Knights of Columbus Council #240, as well as a \$100 donation to the same account made by a generous parishioner. Food totals also include 8 bags of groceries and a smoked ham donated by residents of Mountain Ridge Towers in West Paterson.

In our area, many families are simply trying to make ends meet. They struggle and work hard, but still miss meals week after week, month after month. Your efforts make it possible to get nutritious food to hungry families and provide life-saving groceries to frail seniors and vulnerable children.

Please, as we go about our lives this month, continue to remember the poor and hungry in our midst and prepare for our next collection of groceries and frozen dinners on Saturday, May 20th.
