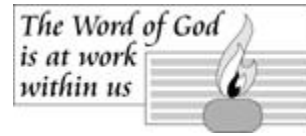

***In Giving We Receive***

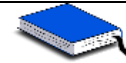

FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY

Our St. Bonaventure community generously
supported the food collection for the Father English
Center, on Saturday, October 21st. Contributions
included:

- 25 frozen dinners 9 bags of used clothing
- 26 bags of groceries \$640 in donations

These totals include a \$500 donation to the
Community Food Bank of NJ for the account of the
Fr. English Food Pantry by our Knights of Columbus
Council #240, as well as \$140 in donations to the
same account made by several generous
parishioners. The \$500 donation was specifically
earmarked for the purchase of 64 frozen turkeys.

As we prepare to enter the holiday season, let us
remember particularly the poor and hungry in our
midst, many of whom rely on us for their
Thanksgiving dinner. While most of us are not able
to host them at our family table, our hearts should
be filled with joy knowing we have unselfishly
provided food for them and their children.
Remember that many are in such dire
circumstances, through no fault of their own, and we
are privileged to serve as the hands of God in lifting
some of their burdens.
