FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Deuteronomy 18:15-20

Moses explains to the people that a prophet will
come from among them, and that they should listen
to this prophet's words, for God has told him of this
prophet. God also tells Moses that anyone who
pretends to speak in his words, or speaks in the
name of other gods shall die.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 7:32-35

Paul tells the Corinthians how an unmarried man or
woman is able to devote themselves fully to God
without concern for the needs of a spouse. Paul
explains that God wants to help them promote good
and devote themselves more fully to God.

Gospel: Mark 1:21-28

As Jesus was teaching, a man with an unclean
spirit came to the synagogue and asked if Jesus
had come to destroy them. Jesus ordered the spirit
out of the man, who shrieked violently as the spirit
departed. The people were amazed at the authority
he had over the spirit.
