FEEDING THE POOR AND HUNGRY

Once again, our St. Bonaventure's community
generously supported the food collection for the
Father English Center, on Saturday, March 24th.
Contributions included:

35 frozen dinners	200 lbs. of rice
44 bags of groceries	7 frozen turkeys
10 cartons of canned goods	8 frozen hams
21 bags of used clothing	\$150 in donations

These totals include 6 frozen dinners and a \$150
donation to the Community Food Bank for the
account of the Father English Food Pantry made by
our Knights of Columbus Council #240. Food totals
also include 5 bags of groceries, 3 frozen dinners, 1
frozen turkey and 2 frozen hams donated by
residents of Mountain Ridge Towers in West
Paterson.

We all know that our bodies can go without food for
a short while but it is almost impossible to move
forward to deal with the hardships in life without
hope. When someone struggles to put food on the
table for themselves or their children, they often feel
that no one cares and that their problems are
insurmountable. When they can turn to the Fr.
English Food Pantry and receive food and get help,
they receive hope as well, and it gives them the
courage to keep going.

Please, as we go about our lives this month,
continue to remember the hungry in our midst and
prepare for our next collection of groceries and
frozen dinners on Saturday, April 14th.
