### **From the Pastor's desk ...**

From May 29<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup>, Fr. Frank and I will join the Franciscan Friars of Holy Name Province at Siena College outside Albany NY for what we call an *Extraordinary Chapter*. The friars will decide on future directions for our fraternities and ministries in the United States. Six provinces will simultaneously vote on a proposal to unite into one province or two, or to remain as we are at six. This decision has implications for our future here at St. Bon's. So, please read on!

During Advent our Provincial Fr. Kevin Mullen O.F.M. sent a letter encouraging friars to participate in a process called *Fraternal Ecology*. The term is inspired by Pope Francis's encyclical letter *Laudato Si'* (2015) where he calls for an integral ecology that responds to "the cry of the earth" (Natural Ecology) and to "the cry of the poor" (Human Ecology). We also have a responsibility to safeguard the welfare of our own friars, and so the term *Fraternal Ecology*.

Here I cite Fr. Kevin's letter directly: "The friars are the most important resource of HNP. With our decline in numbers, we cannot in the future sustain the current number (29) of fraternities-in-mission (FIMs). Under-staffed fraternities are a recipe for burnout and for the extinguishing of the spirit of prayer and devotion. Hence, Chapter 2017 mandates that we review, evaluate and make decisions about the quality and sustainability of our existing FIMs by Chapter 2020. In this way, we will both 'right-size' our province and re-imagine (revitalize) our life and work wherever our FIMs are located."

"How should we live and work? Where should we live and work? How long should we live and work in a given place? The process of *Fraternal Ecology* will help us respond to these questions ... as we reorganize and re-imagine our life and work. Further, in some cases, *Fraternal Ecology* will challenge us to walk forward as "pilgrims not strangers" in faith and itinerancy as we withdraw our province's corporate commitment to some FIMs that we have long been able to support."

Fr. Kevin further explains 3 phases in the process. During Phase 1, each Friary updated its *Fraternal Life Plan* and completed a *Ministry Profile Questionnaire*. To date, this phase has been completed.

We are now in Phase 2 that extends through this entire year to May 2019. A designated friar of HNP is currently preparing a *Preliminary Report* from the information provided from Phase 1. Sometime this year, that friar will meet to discuss that Report with us and with the local Bishop.

Phase 3 begins in May 2019 and extends to January 2020. Based on our feedback and the insights from Phase 2, a *Final Report and Recommendation* will be made for the consideration and decision of the Provincial Council.

Fr. Kevin ends his letter in these words: "In designing *Fraternal Ecology* it has been my belief that this process must be a priority for all of us. My hope is that it will engage us as brothers, as pilgrims, in realistically imagining our future and how it is that we can best live with one another and serve the many people God sends our way. Only with your full cooperation and support will this hope be met. May God bless us and continue the good work he has begun in us."

As pastor of our church and guardian of the friary, I want to be sure that all of you are aware that we are in Phase 2 of *Franciscan Ecology*. I am committed to keeping you informed as we move along in this process.
